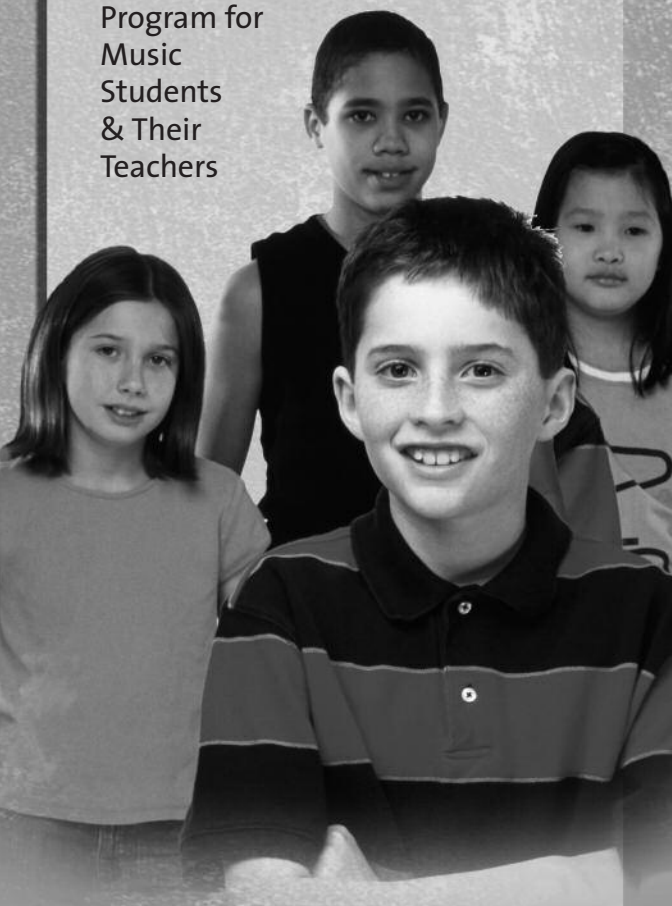

ABOUT ONSITE

OnSite is a program designed for secondary and elementary school music students and their teachers. We offer a great opportunity for your choral students to attend a Vancouver Chamber Choir rehearsal and concert - a unique learning experience. There are no fees or charges for the participating schools.

WHAT WE ARE OFFERING...

- You and your students get to observe the Vancouver Chamber Choir in rehearsal.
- During the rehearsal break one of the singers will explain what we've been doing and answer all the students' questions.
- You and your students will receive complimentary tickets to attend the concert which was being rehearsed. We would like you to be our special guests. (The complimentary tickets are provided only to those who came to the rehearsal. However, additional tickets for parents and other members of your choirs may be purchased for the special OnSite rate of only \$10 each.)
- You will receive explanatory notes and texts beforehand to help prepare for the OnSite experience.

WHAT YOUR STUDENTS GAIN...

- A behind-the-scenes look at the professional rehearsal process.
- A chance to ask the conductor and singers how to achieve the highest performance standards.
- An opportunity to experience the intensity of professional concert performance.

HOW YOU BENEFIT AS A TEACHER...

- An excellent time to stress the importance of focus and good attitude for successful performance.
- An opportunity to broaden students' choral and musical knowledge.
- A chance to pick up useful rehearsal tips and techniques.

Encourage your students' families to come to the concert, too. Knowledgeable parents are more supportive.

Some teachers have their students evaluate what they've learned afterwards by writing letters, emails, or reports. If you do this, please send us copies. This student and teacher response is very useful in maintaining our educational programs.
